CITY OF FRESNO WARMING CENTERS TO OPEN MONDAY NIGHT

FRESNO, CA- The City of Fresno warming centers will be open Monday, January 13, 2025, starting at 7:00 p.m.

The Warming Centers will close at 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 14, 2025, and will not reopen until the projected temperature is at or below 35 degrees.

City warming centers open only when temperatures drop below 35 degrees - based on the National Weather Service in Hanford.

These warming centers are located at Maxie L. Parks Community Center, Mosqueda Community Center and Ted C. Wills Community Center.

The City of Fresno Department of Transportation/FAX will be providing free transportation to anyone who needs to reach a City of Fresno warming center using existing FAX bus routes.
